**Antisocial behaviour (3 items)**

- Items 1 Truants from school
- 2 Tells lies
- 3 Has stolen things on one or more occasions

**Anxiety (6 items)**

- Items 1 Is worried. Worries about many things
- 2 Tends to do things on his own, rather solitary
- 3 Appears miserable, unhappy, tearful, or distressed
- 4 Tends to be fearful or afraid of new things or new situations
- 5 Cries easily
- 6 Stares into space

**Anxiety (5 items)**

**Anxiety (3 items)**

**Prosocial behavior (10 items)**

- Items 1 If there is a quarrel or dispute will try to stop it  
2 Will invite bystanders to join in a game  
3 Will try to help someone who has been hurt  
4 Spontaneously helps to pick up objects which another child has dropped (e.g. pencils, books, etc.)  
5 Takes the opportunity to praise the work of less able children  
6 Shows sympathy to someone who has made a mistake  
7 Offers to help other children who are having difficulty with a task in the classroom  
8 Helps other children who are feeling sick  
9 Comforts a child who is crying or upset  
10 Volunteers to help clear up a mess someone else has made

**Proactive aggression (3 items)**

- Items 1 He gets other kids to gang up on a peer that he does not like  
2 Uses physical force (or threatens to use force) in order to dominate other kids  
3 Threatens or bullies others in order to get his own way

**Reactive aggression (3 items)**

- Items 1 Always claims that other children are to blame in a fight and feels that they started the whole trouble  
2 When he has been teased or threatened, he gets angry easily and strikes back  
3 When a peer accidentally hurts him (such as by bumping into him) he assumes that the peer meant to do it, and then overreacts with anger and fighting
